(Surprise feeding sessions: \$1.00 per person.)

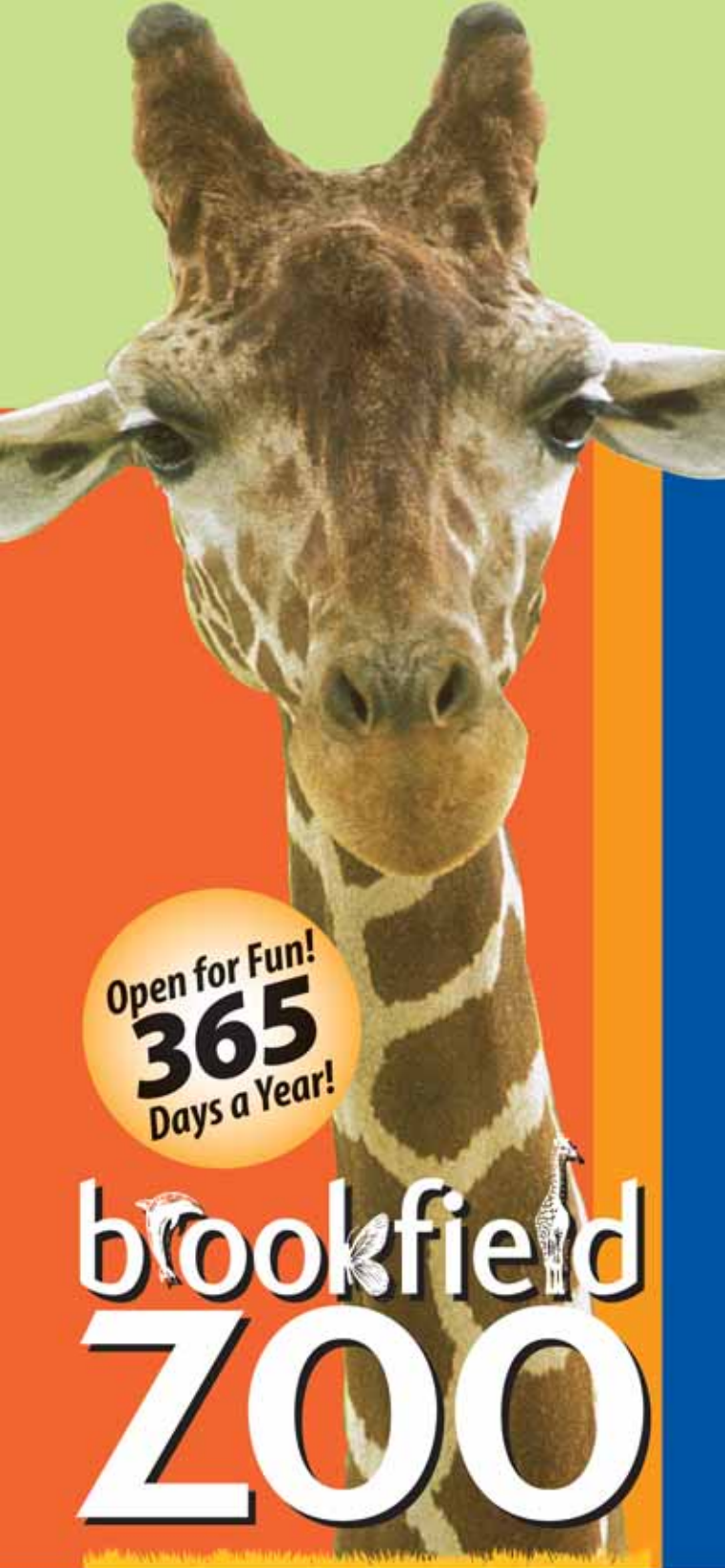

### Arriving By Car

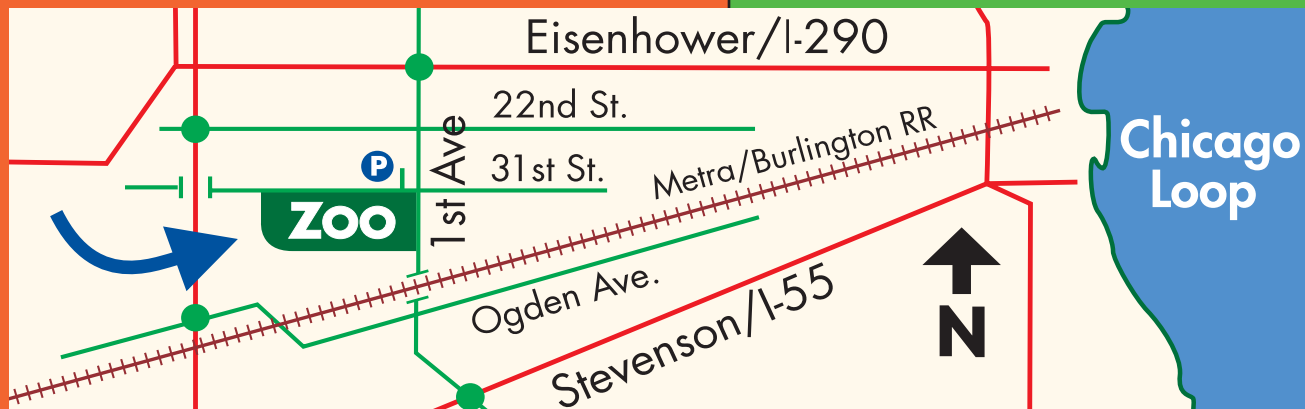
