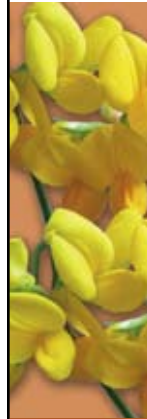

# Activities in the Tetons

## *On The River*

**Fly-Fishing:** Grand Teton National Park and nearby Yellowstone are known for some of the most epic fly-fishing waters. The challenging Snake River winds throughout the Park, attracting anglers from around the country.

**Wild & Scenic Rafting Trips:** Experience a unique view of the Tetons and wildlife from aboard an inflatable river raft. This trip puts you right on the water and provides unparalleled opportunities for wildlife viewing and sightseeing in the Park.

## *On The Lake*

**Jackson Lake Cruises:** Narrated scenic cruises along the waters of this glacial lake are fun for everyone. Breakfast and dinner cruises to Elk Island are available as well.

**Boat Rentals:** Explore Jackson Lake by canoe or motorboat for fishing or a scenic adventure.

**Swimming:** Always a favorite for our family guests, wade on the shores or dive in for a nice cool swim in one of the many lakes. A heated pool is also available at Jackson Lake Lodge for guests of all our lodges.

## *In the Meadows*

**Horseback Riding:** Our guided horseback rides are a spectacular way to view Grand Teton National Park. Trail rides are one or two hours with breakfast and dinner available.

**Hiking:** Exploring on your own is a popular activity in the Park. Feel free to ask our staff for a recommendation, then pack a lunch, plenty of water, and discover the wildflowers, wildlife and solitude that bring our guests back year after year.
