If you're looking for something fun to see and do, Rolla's local attractions will keep you coming back time and time again. Rolla offers unique historical attractions, performing arts, wineries, museums and outdoor adventure.

Blue Bonnet Special Steam Train — This train is symbolic of Rolla's railroad history dating back before the Civil War. Located in Schuman Park at 16th and Walnut Streets. (573) 364-4278
